Membership Benefits Policy Reminder

We are happy to coordinate and extend many benefits to our members, including the retail discounts listed above and reciprocal admission to other gardens through the American Horticultural Society's (AHS) Reciprocal Admissions Program (RAP).

However there have been a few people whose unsavory behavior has created undue frustration, especially at the storefronts of our retail partners and other AHS-RAP participating gardens. When someone uses membership in our organization to intentionally create havoc somewhere, such behavior not only reflects poorly on that person, but also upon our whole organization and the Arboretum itself, and it jeopardizes multiple levels of community and corporate support.

Please follow these policies and ground rules for the benefits of our membership program:

- Friends of BCA memberships are on an annual calendar cycle, all expiring on December 31 and needing to be renewed each year, except for "Lifetime" membership levels.
- Membership benefits are just that benefits <u>for members</u>. Not their neighbors, friends, or family (except as specifically allowed in our designated "Family" membership levels.) If your friend is interested in the plant nursery discounts that our members receive, please encourage them to become a member themselves, rather than cheating the system and creating a scene in a checkout line.
- The discounts set up at various places for Friends members are voluntary agreements these business owners have made out of their good-will for our organization. As with any discount they offer, this discount is subject to their terms and conditions.
- When requesting the member discount at one of our organization's participating supporters or AHSassociated garden, please expect and be prepared to provide <u>your</u> unexpired membership card with your name (and possibly your photo ID also) at checkout.
- If you are unable to provide their cashier/manager with satisfactory proof of your current membership status in our organization, expect that they won't apply the discount, and accept that decision; don't argue or cause a public scene.
- The intent of the American Horticultural Society's Reciprocal Admission Program (RAP) is to reward people for their generous support of their "home" public garden by extending their local garden's membership benefits to hundreds of other gardens nationwide, so they can visit other far-away gardens while on vacation. We do appreciate having members and supporters "from coast to coast", but we also hope they are not using membership with us for dishonest goals such as intentionally cheating another garden out of the funding streams they rely upon.
